About Recovery Connections

We opened our Recovery Connections Mobile Team in 2017. We offer services in Erie County, Niagara County and Alleghany County. Currently, we have five counselors that offer individual one-on-one counseling services for substance use and mental health needs. We offer different services as well that are designed to aid in the treatment process. These includes Medication Management, Peer Support Services and Health Monitoring (nursing/medical services). In addition, we offer rapid access services to receive Medication Assisted Treatment for opioid and alcohol use. We differ from traditional clinics because we travel to you, in the community, to provide our treatment services. All individual counseling, peer support and health monitoring services are provided at your residence or place of your choice. For medication management, we offer assistance in transportation to those appointments, as needed. If there is something that we do not offer that you think would help you in your recovery, our staff would be happy to refer you elsewhere to get that extra support.
